WATER QUALITY

Current Issues

- Washington Regional Office – Office has power. Floodwater came right up to office door but offices are mostly in good shape. Moving vehicles to higher ground paid off.
- As of now, Seaboard, Conway and Woodland in Northampton Co. all have full power and are up and running.
- Beaufort Co. – Aurora – wastewater treatment plant inaccessible – trees down, town is cutting way in.
- Carteret Co. – Brandywine Bay – sewer system overflows
- Chowan Co. – Edenton – multiple sewer system overflows, estimate 35,000 gallons total
- Craven Co. – Carolina Pines – sewer system overflows
- Currituck Co. – Corolla Light – sewer system overflows
- Dare Co. –
 - Village at Nags Head – sewer system overflows
 - Kinnakeet Shores – near Avon, development vacated, plant had planned shutdown
- Duplin Co. – Guilford Mills, Kenansville – discharged chlorinated water
- Edgecombe Co. –
 - Tarboro – Town has no power. Generators are being used at wastewater treatment plant and lift stations.
 - Princeville – At 4 p.m., one ongoing sewage system overflow that is (<1000 gallons so far) due to rising water levels overwhelming pump station. They report a 3,200 gallons sewer system overflow that has been stopped. Generators are being fueled. They expect power to be out 3 to 10 days- generators will continue to be fueled as needed. [They will continue to try to use vacuum trucks at lift stations. But, it is anticipated this may overwhelm the next downstream lift station. This due to the amount of water, these pumping efforts may not prevent sewer system overflows.]
- Franklin Co. – Lake Royale – Small package wastewater plant has power. Progress Energy working on restoring power to subdivision. Note: there are three lift stations without power, but they are not receiving flow (e.g. bath houses). They anticipate power being restored today.
- Halifax Co. –
 - Scotland Neck – wastewater treatment plant and pump stations still on generator power. No overflows. Fueling operations as needed.
 - Enfield - Wastewater plant and pump stations on generator power. Generator at plant has been repaired and influent no longer bypassing. Fueling operations as needed. One pump station is having electrical problems but an electrician will assess this afternoon (4 pm). Lift station level is o.k.
- Hyde Co. – Fairfield – reported sewer system overflows
- Nash Co. – contacted Bailey – has power, no problems
- New Hanover Co. – Cape Fear Public Utilities – yesterday power and generator failed at pump station #58 near the airport. Discharged 99,000 gallons raw sewage. Currently in good shape.
- Northampton Co. - Rich Square - Wastewater Plant on generator power. Using one portable generator to pump down multiple lift stations (They are towing a generator from pump station to pump station. They then use a quick connect and pump station down and move to the next station -since this morning.) No sewer overflows to report. Level in wastewater treatment plant lagoon has risen but will not breach. No problems reported at the wastewater plant. Fuel is available as needed. Power is out throughout town.
- Pamlico Co. – Bay River – serves Oriental, Grantsboro and surrounding area, several sewer system overflows
- Perquimans Co. – Hertford – spill at wastewater treatment plant – 500 gallons
- Pitt Co. – Contentnea MSD – serves Grafton and Aden, several sewer system overflows and bypasses. Tertiary filters are offline – providing partial treatment using chlorine for disinfection.

- Sampson Co. – Clinton – provided intermittent treatment to 167,256 gallons of wastewater; high influent levels – untreated wastewater going to holding pond – 196,000 gallons
- Wayne Co. – Town of Freemont UPDATE – lagoon and sprayfield system in good shape, no spills

Next actions

- DWQ Incident Command to have phone conference Monday a.m.
- Will continue communication with permitted facilities and evaluate next actions.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Current Situation

- The Pitt County Landfill on Allen Road is open until 7 p.m. tonight to begin receiving storm debris. All peripheral container sites are open except the Bethel (no power) and Port Terminal (inundated) locations.
- Currituck County will not need to activate any temporary disaster debris storage sites at this time.
- Camp Lejeune reported that power has been restored. Leachate pumping resumed as normal. No significant damage or erosion of the landfill cap was noted at any of their permitted facilities or at the closed landfill.
- Onslow County reported no significant damage or erosion on its landfill cap. They plan to start hauling storm debris tomorrow.
- The N.C. Department of Transportation will begin hauling to the Jones County Mayville temporary disaster debris storage site tomorrow.
- Craven County activated the Creekside Park site, which was conditionally approved. They are planning to store waste there starting Monday morning.
- Tyrrell County has expressed interest in activation of a site for disaster debris. Planning is underway at this time.
- Dare County plans to use the Salvo Campground site for temporary storage and the Dare County Landfill. Both sites have been activated for use.
- Greene County will direct hurricane debris to its landfill. No temporary disaster debris storage sites will be issued, as the landfill is permitted for this activity.
- Robeson Counties Solid Waste Director reported no damage and no sites will be needed.
- Bladen Counties General Services Manager had no damage to report.
- Fort Bragg Solid Waste Manager Sid Williamson stated that there were no solid waste issues to report at Fort Bragg and at the landfills.
- Hoke County Solid Waste Director Don Russell reported no damage.
- Scotland County Engineer Jim Blackwell reported no damage.
- Gates County is requesting assistance. Mary Whaley, Solid Waste Section Environmental Senior Specialist, will visit the area Monday morning with county Emergency Management staff to provide assistance with siting the needed disaster sites.
- Jason Watkins, Solid Waste Section Western District Supervisor, will be at the EOC tonight until Monday morning at 7 a.m. The number for the EOC Solid Waste Desk is (919) - 733-3797.

N.C. Aquarium on Pine Knolls Shore

Current Situation

- We remain closed to the public
- Have completed damage assessment, significant items include downed trees, damaged asphalt shingles and the loss of sea water intake system
- Remain on generator backup power
- No loss of animal life

Operational Priorities

- Engage tree service to deal with fallen trees
- Begin repair work to get sea water intake system operational
- Plan replacement of sea water intake pier
- Minor debris cleanup
- Should be able to reopen to the public on Monday

N.C. Aquarium at Fort Fisher

Current Situation

- All normal business operations have resumed

Washington

AIR QUALITY

Current Situation

- Staff members in Washington regional office have inspected monitoring stations and found some minor damage and water on floors but nothing serious. Some staff had flooding and wind damage to property, and some still without power. Most plan to report to work on Monday, but some will have to stay home to meet with insurance adjusters.
- No additional problems reported by other regional offices.

COASTAL MANAGEMENT

Current Situation

Elizabeth City District

- Two new inlets were cut through Hatteras Island north of Rodanthe, one about 150 feet across and the second about 450 feet across. The NC 12 washout near Mirlo Beach on Hatteras Island now also appears to be a new inlet breach.

Morehead City District Preliminary Damage Report

Carteret Co.:

- Flooding in Atlantic Beach
- Flooding reported in Salter Path, between Emerald Isle and Pine Knoll Shores, on Shore Drive
- Fishing piers on Bogue Banks experienced moderate to major damages
- Substantial flooding in the Down East Communities
- Many dock structures with minor to major damages
- Estimated 3 to 4 foot tidal surge reported in Bogue Sound
- No reports of beach erosion (if anything accretion on beach profile -raised the level of sand on Bogue Banks)
- No preliminary reports of any substantial damages to beach homes - mostly shingle loss
- Emerald Isle and Atlantic Beach bridges have been reopened

Pamlico Co.

- Substantial flooding/damages in Merit and Oriental

Craven Co.

- Havelock -- Officials estimate that swells from the Neuse River have destroyed 20 to 25 houses in a Craven County neighborhood.
- Harlowe Volunteer Fire Chief Jeremy Brown says 10-foot swells from the Neuse River broke on top of houses as Hurricane Irene stayed over North Carolina for hours. Brown says the number of damaged structures may increase since reports of destruction were still coming in Sunday.
- Substantial flooding and tree damages in Fairfield Harbor
- 13 damaged but habitable structures
- 11 structures with minor damage
- 18 structures with major damage/destroyed

Washington District

- No new information since last update.

Wilmington District:

- No new information since last update.

Coastal Reserves:

- The Beaufort reserve office will be closed tomorrow due to power and internet outages. Some staff will likely work to conduct the site assessment at Rachel Carson.

- Power has been restored at the Wilmington reserve office.

Operational Priorities

- Assist DOT with NC 12 repairs.
- DCM staff will perform further damage assessments on Monday.
- Elizabeth City district manager will decide Monday if satellite DCM office is needed.
- Thorough assessments of reserve sites will begin tomorrow.

LAND RESOURCES

Current Situation

- No problems with dams reported at EOC as of this time and no tasks assigned as of this time.
- All Wilmington Regional Office staff accounted for as reported by Dan Sams, Regional Engineer.
- No contact established with Washington Regional Office staff after last contact from Ricky Peed (see previous situation report).
- Have informed Steve Davis that Land Quality Section will be ceasing operation at the EOC effective 4:45 p.m. Aug. 28.

Operational Priorities

Remain prepared to assign and dispatch inspection teams to problem dam sites, reported or suspected. Wilmington Regional Office will have all staff in the field on Monday inspecting high hazard dams as a precaution. Land Quality Section RCO will meet tomorrow AM to de-brief and establish further course of action.

MARINE FISHERIES

Current Situation

- Crews will start tire pick-up on Bogue Banks tomorrow at 10 a.m. Those picking up tires will have an 8 a.m. briefing on procedures, safety and where they need to go.
- The Morehead City offices has power although the air compressor is not fully operational; but the office will be open for business. The LAN will be placed back into operation tonight. Staff is being notified of the office opening.
- Still do not know operational status of the Elizabeth City and Manteo offices. They may still be closed if no power and may not be able to open.
- The Marine Fisheries Commission meeting is still scheduled to meet in Raleigh this week.

WATER RESOURCES

Current Status

- Regional office staff continue to contact water systems to determine their status.
- Thirty-nine systems in Beaufort, Bertie, Brunswick, Carteret, Craven, Lenoir, Martin, New Hanover, Onslow, Pamlico, Pender and Pitt counties have issued boil water advisories.
- This afternoon, 293 out of 378, or 78 percent of systems that have reported, are operating with no advisory. The Public Water Supply staff will keep an eye on those needing backup power and those on “stored water only.” N.C. WaterWARN staff are trying to get a generator from Raleigh to Bertie County today. They are looking at the numbers of affected systems and urging systems to request help if they need it.
- The attached spreadsheet lists all the systems that have reported their status, except the systems that are operating normally.
